Jean thanked Karen Vogt for serving as vice president for the past several years.

The Architecture Committee members are Jim Burton, Sandy Edmondson and Kent Zaitz.

If anyone plans to change the exterior color of their house they must contact the committee and go through a color designer for approval. To repaint the same color no action is needed. Andy makes a brief explanation of HOA rules to all new owners.

Andy presented the budget, He explained that in 2012 we budgeted \$17,025 and spent \$14,839 because of reduced snow removal. However, irrigation water expense was up. We are trying to build the reserve up to \$10,000 and it is now at \$8,310. Dues will stay at \$450/ year. Payment due to Andy Edmondson by April 1.

Andy had Torii (landscaping company) look into upgrading the landscaping of the circles in the 3 cul-de-sacs. At \$1000 each we decided to try and include the cleanup of at least one with this year's cleanup day.

CLEAN UP DAY MAY 4 with rain date May 11. This is subject to change. However, we emphasize the more homeowners participating the better our street will look.

Centennial Wood sign up date. Gail Smith and Murray Lull met with Brad Rausch, a carpenter, to discuss repairs. We will encase the rotting wood bar that holds the sign letters in an alternative wood and, if practicable, change the name to "Centennial Trail". The cost will be approximately \$1000. Timbers will be replaced by volunteers.

The city requires all trees be of an eight foot clearance over sidewalks and trails. Shrubs are not to jut out into the walk or trail. If the homeowner does not comply the city will do it and bill the owner.
